I am writing to tell you about the next UNA talk. It will take place at 1pm on Friday 20th July in the Friends Meeting House, Upper Goat Lane, Norwich NR2 1EW. The talk will be on the Palestine Trauma Centre and it will be given by David Harrold who is the Chair of the Board of Trustees at the Palestine Trauma Centre UK.

Because of the administrative/political split between Gaza and the West Bank, there is no unified national plan for mental health services. This means that training opportunities provided through PTC (GAZA) and PTC (UK) are enormously valuable.

There are currently four main projects run by the team at PTC (Gaza) and supported by PTC (UK);

They are:

1. Family Therapy
2. Focusing
3. The Friday of Joy Initiative
4. Psycho-Social Support

This will be an interesting talk and I hope as many as possible will come to hear about this essential work in an area that is constantly under threat from Israel and which lacks vital water, medicines and food.
